I pursue shapes and colors. My semi-abstract, expressionist portraits tell a story of whimsical spontaneity. Based on an underpainting my art begins to emerge as color and texture are added layer by layer. The landscapes pull the viewer into a world of color, light, and emotion. My body of work has developed and evolved over time, with much of the outcome being driven by creative impulses.

Originally from Tennessee, Kelly Fischer has lived in Switzerland for the past thirty years. She maintains strong connections in both countries, spending equal time between her studios in Bern, Weehawken, and Memphis. Her paintings have been featured at numerous galleries and exhibitions, including Art Basel Miami, the Austrian Biennale, and the Venice Biennale. Aside from art, Kelly has published eleven children's books and is the former founder and head of the English Montessori School of Bern.

# CURATOR

## Andrés Linares-Guerrero

Andrés Linares-Guerrero is a distinguished Swiss-Colombian art curator and cultural consultant with extensive experience in contemporary art curation, international art markets, and cultural diplomacy. He holds a Master's Degree in Art Market Studies from the University of Zurich's Faculty of Philosophy and a Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS) in Global Marketing from the University of Liverpool, combining his academic knowledge with hands-on curatorial expertise.

His professional journey includes curating and managing exhibitions for international art fairs such as AQUA in Miami Beach and Palm Beach, working closely with artists, collectors, and institutions to develop strategic cultural initiatives. Andrés has collaborated with leading galleries and cultural institutions, curating impactful exhibitions that explore themes of identity, abstraction, and cross-cultural dialogue.

His curatorial practice emphasizes storytelling through visual language, focusing on contemporary abstraction and its emotional depth. He has worked on projects highlighting emerging and established artists, including the work of Swiss artist Kelly Fischer, among others, and has contributed critical essays and exhibition texts that enrich the viewer's experience. Additionally, he has written extensively for press publications on art investment strategies and market trends.

Andrés has represented Colombia at the International Association of Art Critics (AICA) congress in Valparaíso, Chile, further solidifying his global cultural presence. He has also developed a critical art theory focusing on decolonization, challenging historical narratives and promoting inclusive perspectives in contemporary art discourse.

Beyond curation, Andrés has extensive experience in art consultancy, guiding private collectors and organizations on acquisitions and collection management. His diplomatic background, with roles in embassies and cultural programs, has further enhanced his ability to build bridges between cultures through art.

Currently based in London, Andrés is dedicated to expanding his curatorial practice while developing new projects that connect European and Latin American art narratives. He remains passionate about fostering cross-border collaborations and supporting artists in sharing their unique perspectives with a global audience.
